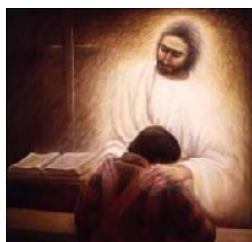


Infant Baptism Preparation

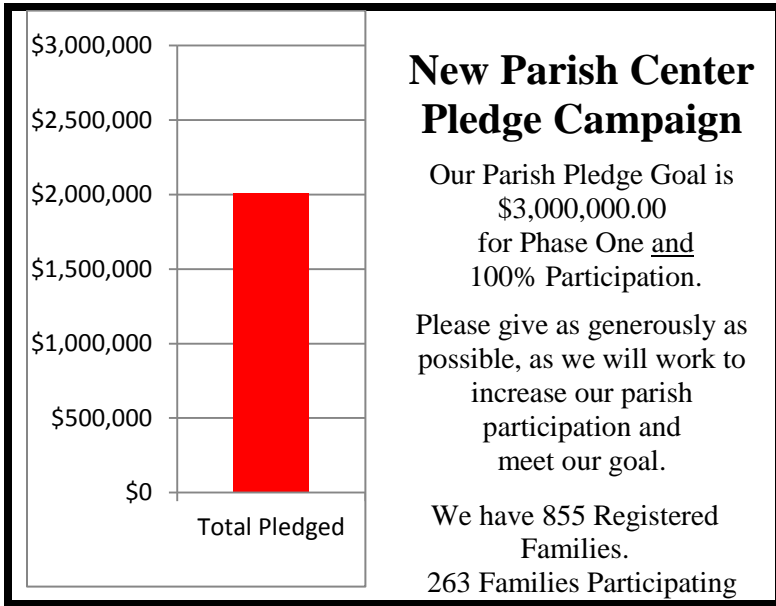

Kairos Cookie Bakers Needed!!



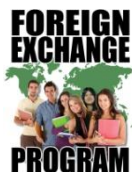
