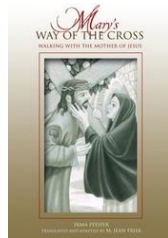


KNOW ANYONE INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?

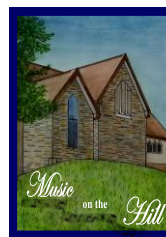
