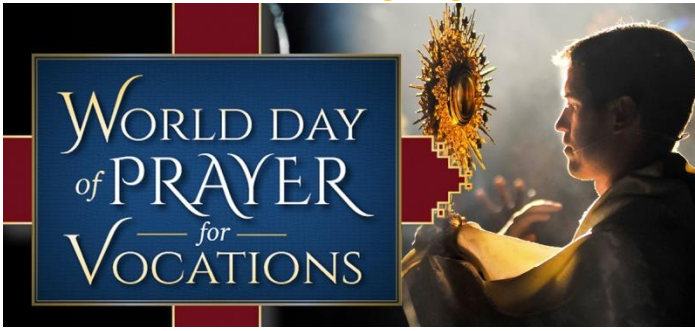

BI-MONTHLY MASS OF HEALING MAY 20, 6:30 PM, SAINT JOSEPH CATHEDRAL. Being the Marian Month of May the Mass "Mary, Health of the Sick" will be celebrated. Following the Mass a Healing Service will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Veneration of relics of the True Cross. Each person then will then have an opportunity to speak individually with one of several priests present to discuss their particular situation and receive a prayer of healing; the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will also be available. The Healing Service will conclude with Benediction. All persons who seek Christ's healing are invited – especially those who suffer with addictions, mental health issues, physical illness and infirmities (e.g. cancer and other debilitating diseases and conditions), in addition to those seeking emotional and spiritual healing. Confessions will be available beginning at 5:30 p.m. All caregivers, family members, and members of the medical community are invited as well. Bi-monthly Healing Masses take place at the Cathedral on the third Monday of the month. In 2019, Bi-Monthly Healing Masses will also be celebrated on July 15, September 16, and November 18. Secured parking is available off East Gay Street. Handicap elevator access to the Cathedral is located off the Broad Street Courtyard. Candlelight Rosary Procession Join Bishop Brennan and other faithful in the Candlelight Rosary Procession in honor of the anniversary of the first apparition of Our Lady of Fatima. Date: **Monday, May 13, 2019** Time: 7-9PM Location: The procession starts at Holy Family Parish, 584 W Broad St, Columbus, OH 43215 and ends at St. Patrick Parish, 280 N Grant Ave, Columbus, OH 43215.

Parking Option #1: Park at St. Patrick Parish starting at 6PM and take the shuttle bus over to Holy Family Parish for the start of the Rosary. The last shuttle bus leaves St. Patrick at 6:40.

Parking Option #2: Park at Holy Family Parish and take the shuttle bus to Holy Family Parish after the Rosary and Litany are completed.

A brief music and prayer service will occur upon arrival at St Patrick Parish including Benediction. For those who are unable or would prefer not to participate in the 2 mile procession, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed and the rosary prayed at St Patrick Parish beginning at 7PM, awaiting the arrival of those in the procession. A light reception will be served in Patrick Hall at St Patrick's Church following the music and prayer service.
