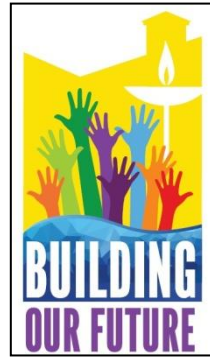
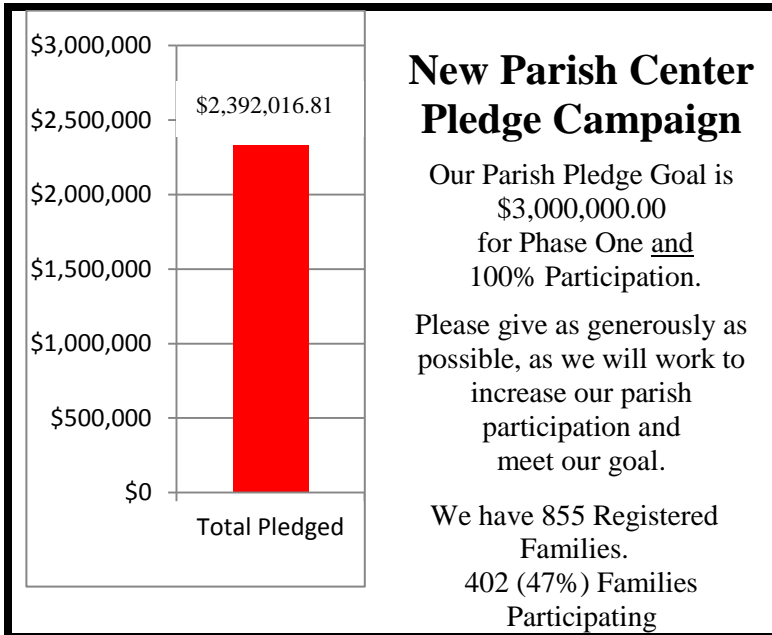
**Corpus Christi Eucharistic Adoration**
