

Greetings Parents:

We are working diligently to provide a safe, learning environment for our students and catechists as we start in-person PSR for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. This might mean some of the protocols we start with may change to improve flow and workability. We will begin with these basic protocols in place and see how things flow on Wednesday evening. If your child is a Sunday PSR attendee please check your email on Thursday or Friday in case of last minute instructions.

And so, here are the details for PSR:

- Masks are required to be worn
- Social distancing will be in place
- Increased and rigid cleaning will be observed
- Supplies will have two categories – individual and shared\*
  - Individual supplies such as pencils and crayons will be kept sorted, unique to each student.
  - Shared supplies such as scissors and glue bottles will be rigorously cleaned after each use but will be returned to communal storage for reuse.
- Entering and exiting the building will be from the main doors
- No food will be offered (at first)
- Water bottles are permitted to be brought in but we will not have the fountains turned on for refilling.
- Drop-off/Pick-up: Parents are encouraged to drop off and pickup inside the building for the first couple of weeks as we create a plan. In an effort to keep traffic flowing (especially Sunday mornings), please park in an empty spot as opposed to along the front of the building. Thank you for your patience in advance.

We look forward to moving into this phase of in-person PSR and thank you for your support and prayers. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me at the parish office or via email.
